Todd Scher Director – Vero Beach Regional Airport

Todd Scher is the Director at Vero Beach Regional Airport. He is a native and lifelong resident of Vero Beach, and has always had a passion for all things aviation.

Prior to joining the City of Vero Beach and Airport Staff, Todd spent a few years as a Fixed Base Operator manager and enjoyed an 18-year career as a professional pilot, flying with air freight, corporate, charter and regional airline operators. An active pilot since 1973, he holds a Multi-Engine Airline Transport Pilot certificate, is type-rated in the Beech King Air 300/350, Swearingen Metroliner, and the SAAB 340, and has logged over 11,000 hours of flying time.

Todd joined Airport Staff in 1996, hiring on as the Airport Operations Supervisor. After serving in that capacity for 10 years, he was promoted to Assistant Airport Director, primarily responsible for the day-to-day operational safety of the airport, and compliance with Federal and State airport regulations. In January 2021, Todd was promoted to Airport Director.

During his tenure, Todd has developed and taught the Airport Driver Training program, the Aviation Fuel Handling and Fire Safety Standards, a training program for conducting safety inspections of Fueling Agent facilities, and Airport Staff familiarization, training and testing materials.

Todd is a member of Indian River Chapter 99 of the Experimental Aircraft Association, and is active in the FAA Safety Team as a Lead Representative. His dedication to safe airport operations has been recognized by the FAA with the Southern Region Runway Safety Partner award. He frequently gives presentations on the airport to various groups throughout the community.
